

TRANSPORT DOCUMENT	DATE OF SHIPMENT:
MULTIMODAL TRANSPORT DOCUMENT	The date of issuance of the transport document will be deemed to be the date of dispatch, taking in charge or shipped on board, and the date of shipment. However, if the transport document indicates, by stamp or notation, a date of dispatch, taking in charge or shipped on board, this date will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
BILL OF LADING	The date of issuance of the bill of lading will be deemed to be the date of shipment unless the bill of lading contains an on board notation indicating the date of shipment, in which case the date stated in the on board notation will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
NON-NEGOTIABLE SEA WAYBILL	The date of issuance of the non-negotiable sea waybill will be deemed to be the date of shipment unless the nonnegotiable sea waybill contains an on board notation indicating the date of shipment, in which case the date stated in the on board notation will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
CHARTER PARTY BILL OF LADING	The date of issuance of the charter party bill of lading will be deemed to be the date of shipment unless the charter party bill of lading contains an on board notation indicating the date of shipment, in which case the date stated in the on board notation will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
AIR TRANSPORT DOCUMENT	The date of issuance will be deemed to be the date of shipment unless the air transport document contains a specific notation of the actual date of shipment, in which case the date stated in the notation will be deemed to be the date of shipment. Any other information appearing on the air transport document relative to the flight number and date will not be considered in determining the date of shipment.
ROAD, RAIL OR INLAND WATERWAY TRANSPORT DOCUMENTS	Unless the transport document contains a dated reception stamp, an indication of the date of receipt or a date of shipment, the date of issuance of the transport document will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
COURIER RECEIPT	A courier receipt, however named must appear to indicate a date of pickup or of receipt or wording to this effect. This date will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
POST RECEIPT OR CERTIFICATE OF POSTING	A post receipt or certificate of posting must appear to be stamped or signed and dated at the place from which the credit states the goods are to be shipped. This date will be deemed to be the date of shipment.
