



Insurance Document: Originals and Copies under UCP 600

LC Scenario	Requirement
<p>The documentary credit is “silent” as to the number of originals/copies of the insurance document to be presented.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least one original must be presented.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the insurance document is presented in more than one original and does not indicate the number of originals that have been issued, the number presented will be considered to be the number of originals issued.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the insurance document does indicate the number of originals that have been issued, all originals must be presented.
<p>“Insurance document in original and duplicate”.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least one original and one copy, or
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least two originals
<p>“Insurance document in duplicate</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In general, “in duplicate” means that at least one original and the remaining number in copies must be presented
<p>“Insurance document in 2 originals”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (At least) two originals must be presented.
<p>“Full set insurance document”</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least one original must be presented. The number of originals presented will be considered to be the number of originals issued. In this case it is not required that the insurance document indicates the number of originals issued. If the insurance document does indicate the number of originals that has been issued, all originals must be presented.
<p>“Insurance document in one original and one copy”.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (At least) one original and one copy – or (at least) two originals – must be presented.
