

Relevant SWIFT messages: MT700 – Issue of a DC/MT705 – Pre-Advice of a DC/ MT707 – Amendment to a DC/ MT710 – Advice of a Third Bank’s DC/ MT720 – Transfer of a DC

The transportation fields are the following:

Swift Field	Name	Description
44A	Place of Taking in Charge/Dispatch from.../Place of Receipt	This field specifies the place of taking in charge (in case of a multimodal transport document), the place of receipt (in case of a road, rail or inland waterway transport document or a courier or expedited delivery service document), the place of dispatch or the place of shipment to be indicated on the transport document.
Swift Field	Name	Description
44E	Port of Loading/Airport of Departure	This field specifies the port of loading or airport of departure to be indicated on the transport document.
Swift Field	Name	Description
44F	Port of Discharge/Airport of Destination	This field specifies the port of discharge or airport of destination to be indicated on the transport document.
Swift Field	Name	Description
44B	Place of Final Destination/For Transportation to.../Place of Delivery	This field specifies the final destination or place of delivery to be indicated on the transport document.

SWIFT Transportation Fields and UCP 600 ICC:

44E – 44F Port to port shipment (art. 20, art. 21, art. 22 UCP 600 ICC)

44E – 44F Air shipment (art. 23 UCP 600 ICC)

44E – 44F Port to port shipment (when the port of loading or discharge field is completed but with a place which is in fact an inland place and not a port art. 19 UCP 600 ICC*)

44E and/or 44F with 44A and/or 44B: Multimodal transports (art. 19 UCP 600 ICC)

44A - 44B: Multimodal transport document, road, rail or inland waterway transport document, or a courier receipt, postal receipt or certificate of posting (art. 24 or art. 25 or art. 19 UCP 600 ICC)

***D1c ISBP 821 ICC:** When a credit requires the presentation of a transport document other than a multimodal or combined transport document, and it is clear from the routing of the goods stated in the credit that more than one mode of transport is to be utilized, for example, when an inland place of receipt or final destination are indicated, or the port of loading or discharge field is completed but with a place which is in fact an inland place and not a port, UCP 600 article 19 is to be applied in the examination of that document.
